Hod Lipson is a roboticist and author who works in the areas of robotics and artificial intelligence. He and his students love designing and building robots that do what you'd least expect robots to do: Self replicate, self-reflect, ask questions, and even be creative.

An award-winning researcher, teacher, and author, Lipson enjoys sharing the beauty of robotics through his books, essays, public lectures, and radio and television appearances. Hod is a professor of Mechanical Engineering and Data Science at Columbia University, where he directs the Creative Machines Lab, which pioneers new ways to make machines that create, and machines that are creative.
